



# > Before Assembly

The assembly instructions provide important safety directions and information necessary for the correct assembly of the unit. Please read the assembly instructions completely and carefully.

# For Your Safety During Assembly

- Danger of injury by sharp edges. Be sure to wear safety shoes and gloves when assembling the unit.
- Danger of electrocution. Never take the safety equipment out of operation. Never bypass the safety equipment. Ineffective safety equipment could cause harm.
- Work on the electrical supply may only be performed by qualified electricians. This work must be performed in compliance with electrical rules and regulations.
- Use only original fuses with the specified voltage and current ratings.
- When installing the unit, ensure that the color codings of the plugs and sockets match.
- The voltage of the power source must conform to the specifications of SonnenBräune, Inc.
- Do not put the unit into operation if the power lead or the unit is damaged.
- Protect the cables against heat and moisture.



**Transport Damage** 

Check that the unit has been delivered in an good, undamaged condition immediately upon arrival of shipment. Inform the delivery service of any transport damage or missing items. Compare the delivered par's with the packing list. If there is damage, the damage report should be made immediately, at least within four days of delivery. The notification period begins on the date of delivery. For easier clarification, damage should be photographed.

# Notes on Transport Before Assembly

- When transporting, loading or unloading the unit, special care and consideration is necessary. Never use force.
- Do not transport the unit in an assembled condition.
- Only remove the packing material and the transport braces at the final location.
- Replace damaged or worn parts.
- Use only original parts.

#### Installation Site

- Place the unit in a dry room protected against water spray and drops. The air humidity must not exceed 70% at the maximum permissible room temperature of 82.4° F
- The ceiling of the room in which you intend to install the unit must be open for ventilation.
- Always ensure sufficient air circulation in the room.

#### Intended Use

The tanning unit is intended exclusively for cosmetic tanning of the human skin. Other use is not intended. The manufacturer will not accept liability for damages caused by misuse.

# The intended use includes:

- The observation of all notes in the assembly and operating instructions.
- Compliance with the specified cleaning and maintenance work.

# **Assembly Directions**

Depending on your room space, the unit must first be dismantled in at least two components (canopy / bench) before the actual assembly. Instructions for this are to be found on the following pages.

# > Common questions

# Customer responsibility when receiving shipment of bed.

Accepting your tanning bed shipment and unpacking the contents deems the contents sole responsibility of the recipient. Should the boxes or crates be damaged, inspect the contents prior to accepting shipment. If damage exists, contact the delivery carrier and your distributor immediately. SonnenBräune is not responsible for damage that has occurred during shipping, unpacking, or installation of bed. If damage has occurred while in route to destination, the carrier is responsible.

Contact the carrier first, then your SonnenBräune distributor.

# What to expect when special arrangements have been made to include installation with your purchase.

If special arrangements have been made to include the installation, the tanning bed will be delivered to the sight and assembled in the room. All electrical connections from the bed to the ballast trays will be made by the installer. At this point the bed is ready for the electrician to connect power (buck-booster) to the unit. If all the electrical is done (proper voltage and wire supplied) the installer may connect power to the unit.

# What's not included in the tanning bed installation?

There will be no electrical work performed by the installer except on the tanning unit. The installer will not wire the Buck-Boost transformers. The installer will not connect exhaust hoses to the building (Only to the tanning unit). There will be no modification made to the building (walls, ceiling, etc.) by the installer.

# The End-User must supply proper room size and access to the room.

SonnenBräune will not be responsible for dents or scratches to the unit when proper room size and access to the room is not provided (to be determined by the installer). SonnenBräune will not be responsible for damage to the unit during shipping or while being installed by anyone other than a SonnenBräune Certified Installer.

## **Assembly Parts List**


# **Electrical Requirements & Connections**

Your new tanning bed must operate on 220 VAC 60 Hz single phase only. A qualified electrician must be used to connect this appliance to your electrical supply. Your SonnenBräune bed must run between 220 to 230 volts. You should not operate your unit on voltage outside of this range, because you will damage the bed and void the warranty. Please give this information to your electrician and have him/her take a digital voltage reading on your incoming power to determine the exact voltage. If your voltage is not between 220 and 230 volts, you need to purchase a "buck boost" transformer. They are available from SonnenBräune. The purpose of this transformer is to regulate your voltage to correct the level. This is very important to ensuring that your bed is operating properly and in avoiding future problems. To avoid over heating of the unit, do not cover the air vents.



The tanning units are equipped with special UV radiation lamps which generate little UVB radiation for the development of pigments and a high proportion of mild UVA tanning radiation.

- \* The skin is tanged inside the shortest possible time by the optimum composition of the radiation and the
  - After tanning, it is advisable to use a skin lotion.
  - The thickness of the skin is not equal on all parts of the body. This results in differing light sensit vity. In the region of thin parts of the skin (e.g. the female breast), the tanning time should be reduced or sensitive parts of the skin should be covered when a part of the tanning period has expired.
- The attainment of an optimum tan depends on the skin type. This requires a tanning series of five to 10 sessions. Approximately two sessions per week are sufficient to maintain the achieved tan.
- If the skin reacts sensitively (skin tension), you should reduce the tanning period or temporarily interrupt a tanning session.
- In cases of insomnia, the sessions should be taken in the mornings.
- Overly excessive UV sessions in sunlight or with UV units can cause damage to the skin or eyes.
- The skin can become sunburnt after excessive exposure to radiation. Excessive UV sessions in sunlight or with UV units can lead to premature aging of the skin and to an increased risk of skin tumors.

#### Skin Types

The human skin reacts differently to exposure to UV light depending on the skin type. The recommended tanning times specified in the table are not generally applicable, but depend on the skin type. To find the correct tanning time for you (see table of tanning times), choose the appropriate skin type for yourself.

Skin type II: This is the individual that usually burns easily and severely, tans minimally or lightly and peels.

Skin type III: Often referred to as average complexion, burns moderately and tans about average.

Skin type IV: This individual burns minimally, tans easily and above average.

Skin type V: This individual's skin rarely burns, tans easily and substantially.

This exposure schedule provides information on tanning times, depending on the skin type and specific unit.

- Do not exceed the specified tanning times.
- In the first 50 to 80 hours of operation, the unit generates approximately 20% higher power. Reduce the session times specified in the table by approximately 20%.
- The interval between two sessions should be at least 48 hours.
- · Avoid additional sunbathing on the days of the sessions.







## Cleaning the Acrylic in the Canopy

Clean the acrylic with a damp cloth and use only recommended cleaners.

- Open the three catches with the aid of a coin, pressing lightly on the glass with the other hand to prevent it from falling onto the bed acrylic.
- Clean the acrylic from both sides and replace it in the reverse order. (Diagram #13, 1)

## Cleaning the Bench Acrylic

- Open the bed catches with the aid of a coin.
- Then lift the bench acrylic and stand it on its end.
- After cleaning the inside, replace the acrylic, observing that the guide lugs of the acrylic retaining strip are engaged in the provided recesses.
- Then lower the bench acrylic and lock the catches. (Diagram #13, 2)

# Operate the unit only when all safety and protective equipment such as the acrylic is reinstalled

If you notice damage to the tanner (filter, acrylic or timer defects) do not operate unit under any circumstances!




#### > MAINTENANCE

Your tanning bed will require simple maintenance when necessary to maintain proper operation of the unit. Always ensure that your acrylic shields are clean, otherwise the tanning performance will be reduced. For cleaning, use a soft rag and clean the reflectors, as well as the lamps for dust particles. Do not use alcohol or ammonia based cleaners or any coarse abrasive agents.

- The acrylic shield is a special version with 100% UV remittance ability. If it must be replaced, use only a SonnenBräune certified replacement shield.
- When maintaining operation of the unit, replace only with SonnenBräune certified replacement parts.

Warning

SonnenBräune will not be responsible for improperly maintained, old or worn out parts or uncertified replacement parts. Only replace with SonnenBräune certified replacement parts.

Warning

SonnenBräune will not be responsible for equipment that has been outfitted without approved SonnenBräune lamps or FDA equivalent.

Never use normal florescent lamps in the unit.


Use only original spare parts.

Information on the lamps. The tanning lamps can have different shades of color. After long operation, dark spots can occur at the ends of the lamps. This has no effect of the performance and life of the lamp.

Danger of burns
The high-pressure lamp and the filter plate get very hot. Allow the elements to cool down fully before you replace them or clean them.

- · Open the canopy.
- Remove the plate of the canopy as described in the "Cleaning" section.
- Undo the two screws in the filter plate frame (see Fig. 21).
- Swivel out the filter plate with the profiled strips (see Fig. 22).



# Replacing the Reflector Lamps


Before beginning to replace the reflector lamps, switch off the unit.


- Fold the canopy open.
- Open the filter flap of the unit case.
- Switch off the main power.

Begin by removing the acyrlics as described in chapter "Cleaning" on page 24. The reflector lamps can then be removed by rotating them 90% in either direction (see Figure D).

When inserting the reflector lamps, please observe that the coating points towards the housing and that the marking on the reflector lamp is aligned with the socket (see Figure E).

#### >TROUBLESHOOTING

If your unit does not operate satisfactory, several helpful tips are listed below.

#### What to do when the unit will not start.

Your SonnenBräune tanning bed has been equipped with certain safety devices that will not allow the unit to operate under certain conditions that may damage your investment. Here is a list of troubleshooting tests in the event your tanning bed will not start.



All electrical testing and installation of parts must be performed by a certified electrical technician. Your electrician should contact SonnenBräune's Service Department prior to making any adjustments.

All repairs must be performed by a SonnenBräune approved electrical technician. All warranty conditions could be voided if this procedure is not followed.

- Check all safety switches and also check the circuit breaker in your breaker panel to make sure it is on.
- . Check the On/Off switch on the unit. Make sure it is on.

# What to do when the tanning bed will not start when the cooling fans are running.

Your SonnenBraune bed is equipped with a safety device that will not allow the unit to run in the event that the air filtering system becomes clogged with lent or other materials. Prior to notifying your electrician, remove all filters, clean and reinstall. The unit should start at this point. In the event that it does not, call your SonnenBraune service department for further instructions.

# What to check when one or several lamps do not burn.

- Turn the power off.
- Remove the acrylic to inspect lamps and connections.
- Check to see if the lamp is properly fitted.
- If it still will not work, replace the defective lamp with a new lamp. If the new lamp lights, it can be assumed that the old lamp is bad.
- if the lamp still doesn't work, contact your SonnenBräune service representative.

# What to do when you are not satisfied with your tan.

- Review the exposure schedule on page 21.
- Check the exposure positioning. The distance between the tanning surface and body should be two to four inches. In no event should the exposure position be less than two inches between the body and the tanning surface. However, you may lie directly on the tanning surface of the bench.
- Check your power supply. Refer to page 16, and the section referring to "Electrical Requirements and Connections."
- Review section on "Cleaning and Maintenance" starting on page 23. The tanning performance of your tanning bed will be greatly reduced when these procedures are not followed.
- Check the hours on your lamps. They may need replacing.

## > ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION AND SPARE PARTS

Disposal

The separate, environmentally compatible disposal of materials or material residues promotes the reuse of valuable materials.

The reflector lamps should not be put in household waste, but should be disposed of separately (special waste). The lamps must not be destroyed before disposal.

The disposal of wastes from private households and the commercial sector is possible through the public special waste collection points.

Information on disposal can be obtained from your waste department.

Spare Parts

Use only manufacturer approved spare parts as shown on parts list.

If spare parts from other manufacturers are used, this can affect the performance of the unit, and your warranty.
